Submission Guidelines

Chalachitra Sameeksha is a monthly journal published by the Kerala State Chalachitra Academy on behalf of the Department of Cultural Affairs, Government of Kerala. The following are the submission guidelines for authors and contributors:

Authors/Contributors should submit their articles to the email address of Chalachitra Sameeksha at editorial@chalachitraacademy.org.

In addition to the PDF file, editable Word documents should also be provided.

Language and Scope: Chalachitra Sameeksha is a bi-lingual (English and Malayalam), journal that promotes research on film and television. The journal welcomes original articles that have not appeared elsewhere and that are related to film studies and visual culture. The scope of the journal includes film history, film criticism, film theory, film aesthetics, visual culture, television, and other related fields.

Originality and Exclusivity: The submitted article should be original and not previously published in any other publication. Authors/Contributors shall not submit the same article for concurrent consideration of other publications.

Citation and References: The Author/Contributor is free to choose any international style of citation such as MLA, or Chicago Style. However, only one style has to adhere to one article. Keywords and a list of works cited at the end of the article are mandatory. Please include links to web resources that are mentioned or referred to.

Code of Ethics: Authors/Contributors should be very careful in sticking to the code of ethics related to in-text citations while they prepare the article. Each and every quote must be demarcated with double quotation marks. The film title should be in italics.

Plagiarism: Plagiarism is a criminal offense, and it will be reported to the authorities of law and order if found. The Kerala State Chalachitra Academy is dedicated to maintaining international norms for ensuring that research papers are authentic, accurate, and conducted with integrity.

Length: The article needs to have a minimum length of 6000 to 8000 words.

Formatting: The article should be typed in 12-point font, Times New Roman or equivalent (ML fonts or Unicode in Malayalam), double-spaced, and with 1-inch margins on all sides. Please include a cover page that contains the title of the article, the author's name, institutional affiliation (if any), and contact information (email, mobile number, and postal address).

Review Process: Authors will be informed of the outcome of the review process within six weeks of submission.
